Registration Information

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!!

- OPENING DAY:**
Sessions #1 - #4: Camp commences with **Sunday supper**. Campers should arrive between **2:00 p.m.** and **4:00 p.m.** **NO REGISTRATIONS** before this time.

Session #5: Camp commences **after supper on Saturday**. Campers should arrive between **7:00 and 8:00 p.m.** **NO REGISTRATIONS** before this time.

As a preventative measure, we will be doing a head lice check before each camper will be permitted to go to their cabins. If head lice is discovered the camper will be required to return home. **Please remember** to bring medical card, all medication and tuck money to the registration table.
- CLOSING DAY:** Camp ends on Saturday. Campers may be picked up between **9:30 a.m.** and **11:00 a.m.**
- VISITING:** Facilities do not permit meals to be served to the parents on opening or closing days. **NO VISITING** during camp unless prearranged through the Director.
- MEDICAL:** Any medication the camper may need **MUST BE INDICATED BY THE DOCTOR.**
- TUCK SHOP:** There is a **\$2.00 daily limit on purchases of candy/soft drink but sweatshirts, T-shirts, hats, postage stamps and other novelty items are also available for purchase.**
- DISCIPLINE:** The **CAMP DIRECTOR** reserves the right to send home any camper not conforming to camp regulations. **CIGARETTES, ALCOHOL, NON-PRESCRIBED DRUGS, ETC.** are **FORBIDDEN** at camp.
- BUS PICK UP:** Is available upon request from Magog.

- Nice outfit for banquet (please keep in mind the dress code)
- Towel, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste
- Send any medication in the original container, clearly marked with your child's name and dosage information.



OPTIONAL ITEMS:

- Heeled Boots (if you have them for horseback riding)
- Bug Spray
- Camera – Digital Cameras (Pictures may be audited)
- Flashlight, Fan
- Musical Instruments
- Bike Helmet (used for mountain biking and horseback riding)
- Mesh laundry bag
- Water Bottle
- Rainwear
